36. Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé 2008 £15.75
Santa Rita, Chile
Made from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, this zippy rosé has real depth of colour and great intensity of juicy berry fruit flavours.
37. Blanc de Noir Rosé, Buitenverwachting 2008 £16.95
Constantia, South Africa
Attractive peach and strawberry flavours with a long refreshing finish.
38. Côtes de Provence Rosé Carte Noire 2008 £19.50
Maîtres Vignerons de St Tropez, France
Very refined dry rosé, with an attractive floral aroma, redcurrant fruit, and excellent length in the mouth.

sparkling & champagne

39. Blanc de Blancs Duc de Breux NV £16.70
France
Light and delicate, with floral and fruity notes to the fore; fine bubbles and a rounded mouthfeel are complemented by a crisp, dry finish.
40. Premium Rosé Jansz, Tasmania NV £24.70
The nose of this first-class rosé offers lifted notes of rose petals, with fresh cream and nougat. In the mouth, it is rich with the creaminess of the mousse while the Pinot contributes strawberry notes that fill the palate.
41. Champagne Testulat Rosé NV £36.95
France
A light, fruity and delicately coloured champagne with complex fruit flavours of strawberries and cream.
42. Champagne Deutz Brut Classic NV £45.75
France half bottle £23.25
Exceptionally fine Champagne from a Maison founded in 1838, benefiting from the management of 5 generations of the same family, whose quality has been recognised by wine writers including Jancis Robinson and publications such as Wine Spectator and Decanter Magazine. Deutz is currently served in all of Paris' 2* & 3* Michelin restaurants.
43. Dom Perignon 2000 £125.00
France
A Champagne that needs little or no introduction... one of the very finest.

44. Clos du Portail Graves Supérieures 2005 1/2 bottle £14.50
France 75ml glass £2.85
Just over the border from Sauternes, this is of a similar style: rich peach and apricot fruit, notes of honey and spice, and a tangy marmalade finish.
45. Dindarello Moscato Maculan 2007 1/2 bottle £19.70
Veneto, Italy 75ml glass £4.10
Honeyed apricot syrup aromas are followed by beautifully balanced barley sugar and citrus fruit flavours.

white wines

1. Le Bouquet Duboeuf Blanc NV £14.75
Vin de Table, France
Delicate with clean, elegant fruit and a crisp, dry finish.
2. Sauvignon Blanc Ruitersvlei 2007 £14.90
Paarl, South Africa
Rich nose of pineapple, guava and hints of tropical fruits, with undertones of green pepper and asparagus. Crisp and well-balanced.
3. Chenin Blanc Simonsig 2008 £15.45
Stellenbosch, South Africa
Delicately fruity with succulent tastes of guava and clean, fresh, citrus fruits which give way to an ever-developing faintly honeyed finish. A perfectly balanced wine - great for keeping in the fridge door.
4. Sauvignon Blanc Terres d'Azur 2007 £15.80
VdP d'Oc, France
Zesty aromas of lemon, grapefruit and elderflower give way to a classically crisp palate with hints of white peach and a refreshing finish.
5. 'Y' Series Unwooded Chardonnay 2007 £16.90
Yalumba, Australia
A fruit driven wine exhibiting melon and peach fruit with a hint of citrus peel and a fresh, zesty acidity.
6. Pinot Grigio Terre del Noce 2008 £16.95
Vigneti delle Dolomiti IGT, Trentino, Italy
Elegant, dry Pinot Grigio with apple and banana fruit aromas, floral lift in the mouth, and a clean, crisp finish.
7. Villa Bianchi Verdicchio Classico 2007 £18.00
Umani Ronchi, Marches, Italy
Pale straw yellow with greenish reflections and a delicately fragrant bouquet. The palate is dry and soft with a typically citrus rind and hazelnut finish.
8. Casa Semillon Lapostolle 2007 £18.50
Rapel Valley, Chile
Expressive nose with mineral flinty notes combined with mandarin and subtle sweet spices. Medium-bodied, with a crisp and fresh acidity towards the finish.
9. Silenzi Bianco (Vermentino/Nuragus) Pala 2007/8 £19.90
Sardinia, Italy
A fresh wine with good intensity, showing crisp, clean notes of apple, pear, citrus and herbs.
10. Semillon Sauvignon Vasse Felix 2007 £19.95
Margaret River, Australia
Lovely floral notes, lime and lemongrass on the nose with a hint of passionfruit. Fresh and lively flavours of lime, lemon, gooseberries and passionfruit. Long and clean with a refreshing flinty minerality to finish.
11. Mâcon-Villages Domaine Chenevrières 2007 £19.95
Burgundy, France 1/2 bottle £10.50
Wonderful creamy Mâcon, soft-textured and generous, but still with good balance and minerality.
12. Sauvignon Blanc Mansion House 2008 £20.45
New Zealand
Goosberry, redcurrant and lemon aromas, with crisp fruits and a zesty long finish.
13. Viognier, Yalumba 2007 £22.95
Eden Valley, Australia
Aromas of apricot nectar with lifted honeysuckle and orange oil perfume. A long, rich and luscious palate finishing with an aromatic citrus freshness.
14. Petit Chablis Domaine Hamelin 2007 £22.95
Burgundy, France
A ripe Chablis with good weight and intensity. Green apple and pear emerges on the mineral finish.
15. Sancerre Les Boffants 2007 £25.95
Charles Dupuy, Loire, France 1/2 bottle £13.50
Herbaceous grassy Sauvignon fruit with all the flinty mineral style of the Loire.
16. Rully Vieilles Vignes 2005/6 £26.50
Vincent Girardin, Burgundy, France
A rich and intensely fruity wine with fine balancing acidity and a crisp finish.
17. Saint-Romain Morey-Blanc 2005 £39.50
Burgundy, France
A very clean, pure style, though not without weight, good creamy texture, and a whisper of smoke in the background.

It may be necessary to offer an alternative vintage.

red wines

18. Le Bouquet Duboeuf Rouge NV £14.75
Vin de Table, France
A medium bodied red, soft and well-rounded with plenty of fruit.
19. Cabernet Sauvignon Terre del Noce 2007 £15.95
Vigneti delle Dolomiti IGT, Trentino, Italy
Attractive soft berry fruits, a nicely balanced wine - fresh, vibrant easy drinking.
20. Arabella Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 £15.95
Western Cape, South Africa
Brimming with abundant blackcurrant flavours, this full-bodied is a mouthfull of juicy fruit and plum flavours.
21. Shiraz Viognier Yalumba 'Y' Series 2006 £16.90
South Australia
Attractive nose of ripe berry fruits with the Viognier lending notes of apricot blossom and musk. Plush and smooth with a long velvety texture. Well suited to Roast Lamb or Risotto.
22. Merlot Santa Rita Reserva 2007 £17.95
Maipo Valley, Chile
Juicy blackberry and plum flavours are wrapped around ripe tannins and toasted oak.
23. Angus The Bull Cabernet Sauvignon 2006/7 £19.45
Victoria, Australia
Deep in colour with sweet mulberry fruits and smoky oak aromas. Medium to full bodied with juicy fruit flavours and hints of mint. Good structure and ripe tannins with a lingering finish.
24. Rioja Crianza Viña Salceda 2005 £19.75
Spain
An intense, complex nose with aromas of red fruit, blackberries, cranberries and spicy oak notes. The aroma carries through to the delightful medium-bodied palate and the long, elegant finish.
25. Merlot Casa, Lapostolle 2007 £20.45
Rapel Valley, Chile
Clean aromas of ripe red fruit dominate with sweet spices and notes of rosemary and herbs de Provence towards the end. Medium-bodied, well-balanced and fresh.
26. Fleurie La Madone, Georges Duboeuf 2007 £21.50
Beaujolais, France 1/2 bottle £11.45
This famous Cru lives up to its name with a smooth, elegant and - yes - floral wine of immense charm.
27. Pinotage Spice Route 2007 £23.45
South Africa
Warm berry fruit flavours and tobacco spice. Full-bodied and complex.
28. Pinot Noir Cuvée Alexandre 2005 £24.95
Lapostolle, Casablanca Valley, Chile
An intense nose of ripe red fruit, dominated by red berries, cherries and plums, as well as black and white spices. Smoky cedar notes towards the end. The palate is smooth and medium bodied with a silky finish.
29. Crozes-Hermitage Les Launes 2007 £27.95
Delas, Rhône Valley, France
A fruity, medium-bodied Crozes, with aromas of cassis, plums and violets, a supple mouthfeel, and a fine mineral finish.
30. Nautilus Pinot Noir 2007 £31.50
New Zealand
Dark ruby in colour, with an aroma of plum dark fruits and a hint of chocolate. Medium to full-bodied with ripe fruit and oak combining to give great structure and length.
31. Château Musar 2001 £33.45
Lebanon
Made by Serge Hochar, using a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinsault and Syrah grapes, this wine is aged in French oak for 2 years before release, leaving it rich and spicy.
32. Château Yon Figeac Grand Cru 2002 £33.75
St Emilion, Bordeaux, France
Delicate with clean, elegant fruit and a rounded, smooth finish.
33. Châteauneuf-du-Pape Haute Pierre 2006 £34.50
Delas, Rhône Valley, France
Juicy, sweet ripe fruits and impressive backbone of smooth, ripe tannins.
34. Merlot Atalon 2002 £35.75
Napa Valley, USA
Refined, elegant Napa Merlot, with concentrated plummy fruit, cedarwood complexity and exceptional balance for the region.
35. Nuits St. George 1er Cru 2002 £45.00
Les Porrets St. George, Burgundy, France
This wine has an attractive gamey scent with lots of ripe fruit on the palate, rich and full flavoured.
